



### ESCAPING PETER

This week, the children are learning about when Peter escaped from Prison. In this Bible story, God helped Peter escape from prison by sending one of His angels to help him. Because of the power of the Holy Spirit, Peter was able to tell others about Jesus for the rest of his life. To help them remember the significance of this story, they will use the printables provided and tracing paper to create a visual example of Peter in the prison cell but then escaping. This was only possible because of the Holy Spirit's power.



### DIRECTIONS

#### PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print cardstock printables.
2. Cut out the printable frame, Peter, insert card and tracing paper. The tracing paper should be cut to match the Peter square.
3. Have tape, crayons, Sharpies, tracing paper and printables ready for the leaders.

#### DURING THE SERVICE

1. Instruct the children to color the frames and Peter.
2. Have the children draw jail cell bars on to the tracing paper using the Sharpies.
3. Tape the blank insert card to the inside fold in the middle of the frame. Only tape the bottom of the card.
4. Fold the frame along the folding line sandwiching the insert card. Have the children tape the top and left side closed.
5. Next tape the tracing paper over the top of Peter.
6. Show the children how to insert Peter into the frame so the tracing paper and Peter are divided by the insert card.
